The Test is scheduled to be held on **14, 06, 2019**.

### Guidelines for the candidates

#### Eligibility for Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT) - 2019

- (i) Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. programme shall have a Master's degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, will be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/EBC/OBC/Differently-abled categories of candidates.
- (iii) A candidate shall ordinarily be permitted to pursue research for the Ph.D. degree in the subject in which he/she holds Master's degree.

**N.B.:** Appearing candidates of Semester-IV (2017) are eligible to apply.



### Exemptions from the written test of Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT) – 2019

- (1) Candidates who have secured grants for research such as fellowship/scholarship/associate ship etc. by qualifying UGC/NET/CSIR-NET/GATE/MHRDScholarships/TeacherFellowship/DBT/ICMR/ICAR/DST-INSPIRE/CSSIR, ICHR etc.
- (2) Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor who have been appointed on substantive post in the UGC pay scale in the teaching departments or the University or a constituent college of the University who have completed their probation successfully with an experience of at least two years of uninterrupted service would be considered under this category. Teachers appointed in self-finance courses will not be exempted from the test.
- (3) Non-teaching employees of the University, who are holding substantive appointment for more than five years having at least 55% marks in Master's degree in the subject concerned, and with at least two research papers published in any reputed refereed journal or journals identified by the UGC would be considered under this category.

### How to Apply

Application has to be made through online mode only with the requisite Test Fee and coloured self-attested photographs and thumb impression (right in case of female, left in case of male) from **19.05.2019 to 10.06.2019 11:59 PM**. No application will be accepted after the due date. Incomplete application will be rejected.

**Note:** The candidates, who are exempted from PAT 2019, are also required to apply with requisite Fee.

## Procedure for Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT) – 2019

### Written Test

Written test will be comprised of two papers of 100 marks each.

**Paper -I: 100 marks** – objective/ multiple choice questions on general and research aptitude.

**Paper -II: 100 marks** – subjective type in the subject concerned based on Semester System syllabus (excluding elective papers) of the Post-Graduate courses of the B.N.Mandal University, Madhepura, Bihar.

**The minimum qualifying marks for written test will be as follows:**

For General candidates – 50% aggregate marks

For Reserved category candidates – 45% aggregate marks

### Merit List

The subject wise merit list will be prepared on a scale of 100 including marks in Master degree; weightage on PAT/NET/BET/JRF and Interview as mentioned in the following Table i.e. maximum weightage on marks obtained in Master's Degree Programme as 70 plus maximum weightage on PAT/NET/JRF as 10 plus Interview of 20 marks.

Candidates will be selected following the prescribed reservation rules of Bihar Government.

## Instructions to the candidate

**Paper I** – Multiple choice questions (MCQ).

No. of Questions – 50 Full Marks:  $2 \times 50 = 100$

Duration of examination: 1 hour

There will be no negative marking.

Students are not allowed to take out the questions booklets of Paper I.

**Paper II** – Essay Type/Subjective,

Duration of Examination: 2 Hours.

Test will be based on the syllabus (excluding elective papers) of the Post-Graduate Degree Courses of B.N.Mandal University.

The paper will be divided into three Groups:

03	C	$2 \times 15 = 30$	Total Four questions to be set of which two are to be answered (expected length of each answer 500 words approximately).

## **Availability of Admission Card**

PAT- 2019 admission card will be uploaded on university website in the 11<sup>th</sup> Jun 2019. The copy of admit card must be attested by Head of the Department/principal of college last attended or by gazette officer. It is necessary for the candidates to attest photograph, signature as well as put thumb impression in the admit card to appear the examination.

### **General information to the candidates**

Shield Coding Answer book will be provided to the candidates in the examination hall 15 minutes before the start time of the examination and they will have not unshielded the answer book until and unless start single has not been given by the invigilator. If candidates unshielded the answer book prior to start of the examination they may be expelled from the Test. The successful result of Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT) will be **valid for three years** from the date of declaration/publication of result. The PAT will be under the preview of the Rule of RTI Act, 2005.

### **Test Centre**

Test will be held at Madhepura centers and it will be communicated/announced properly in time.

### **Paper-I: General and Research Aptitude Test.**

All questions with multiple choices, each correct answer carries 2 Marks. There will be Full Marks: 100, Total number of Questions: 50 and no negative marking. Duration of Exam will be of 1 Hour.
